"Now in those days John the Baptist came, preaching in the wilderness of Judea, saying, 'Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

MARK 6:12

"They went out and preached that men should repent."

LUKE 24:46-48

"And He said to them, 'Thus it is written, that the Christ would suffer and rise again from the dead the third day, and that repentance for the forgiveness of sins would be proclaimed in His name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things."

II. WHAT DOES REPENT MEAN?

"The notion of repentance follows from the notion of sin. It suggests that sin is an act or attitude which can be corrected by some change in the person."

5. Turning to Christ -

Repentance and faith go together.

"Repent and believe."

Matthew 4:17, "Repent." Why? "for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

"I have this against you, that you have left your first love. Therefore remember from where you have fallen, and **REPENT** and do the deeds you did at first."

"Remember what you have received and heard; and keep it, and **REPENT**. Therefore if you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what hour I will come to you."

V. WHY IS REPENTANCE NECESSARY?

1. BECAUSE GOD COMMANDS US TO REPENT-

Acts 7:30

"God... commands all men everywhere to repent."

2. BECAUSE SIN OFFENDS GOD

"If you love Me, you'll keep my commandments."

3. BECAUSE WITHOUT REPENTANCE FELLOWSHIP WITH GOD IS IMPOSSIBLE


4. BECAUSE ETERNAL PUNISHMENT IN HELL AWAITS THE UNREPENTANT
